## 2. Cozy Garland of Felt Santas



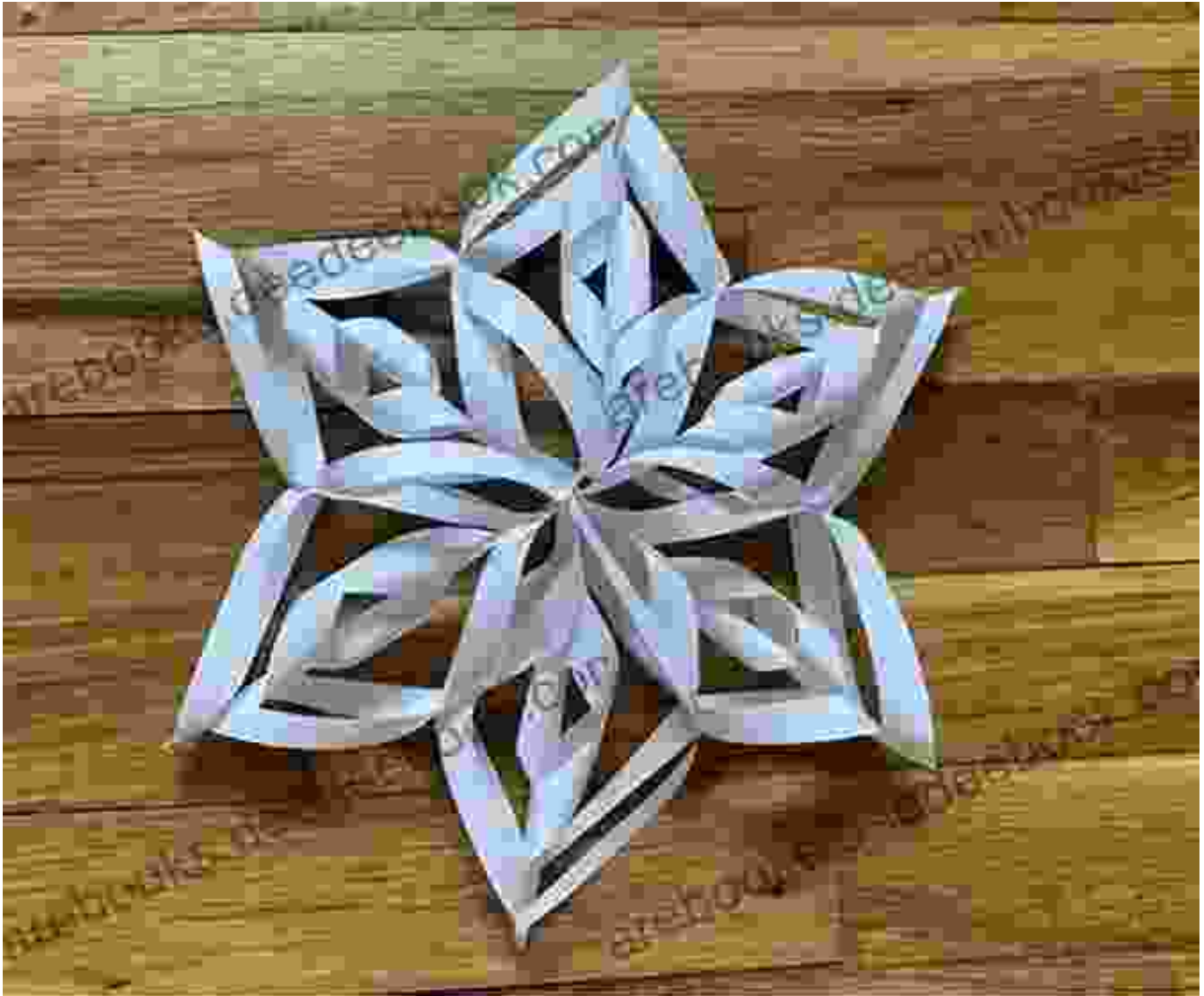

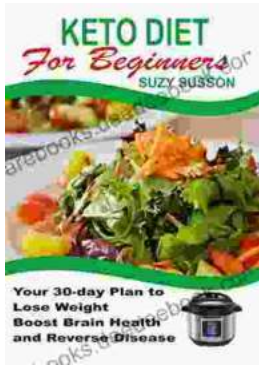
