

Day By Day: The Producer Perspective

- Add limiting to prevent the song from clipping


Tips for Becoming a Successful Producer

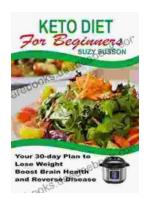
