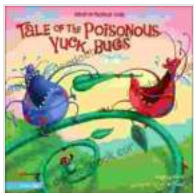


The Tale of the Poisonous Yuck Bugs

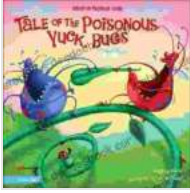

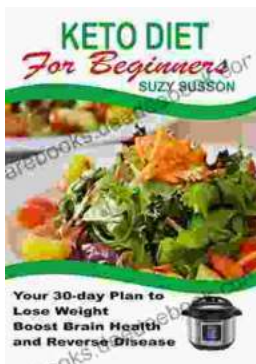
